

HOUSE MEMBERS' RATINGS

In the following list, House members are assigned separate scores for their roll-call votes on key economic, social, and foreign policy-national security issues during 1999. The 435 members are rated in each of the three issue categories on both liberal and conservative scales, with the scores on each scale given as percentiles. An economic score of 72 on the conservative scale, for example, means that the member was more conservative than 72 percent of his or her House colleagues in that issue area during 1999. (An * means that the member missed more than half of the rated votes.)

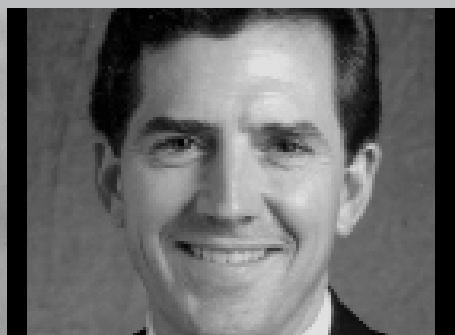

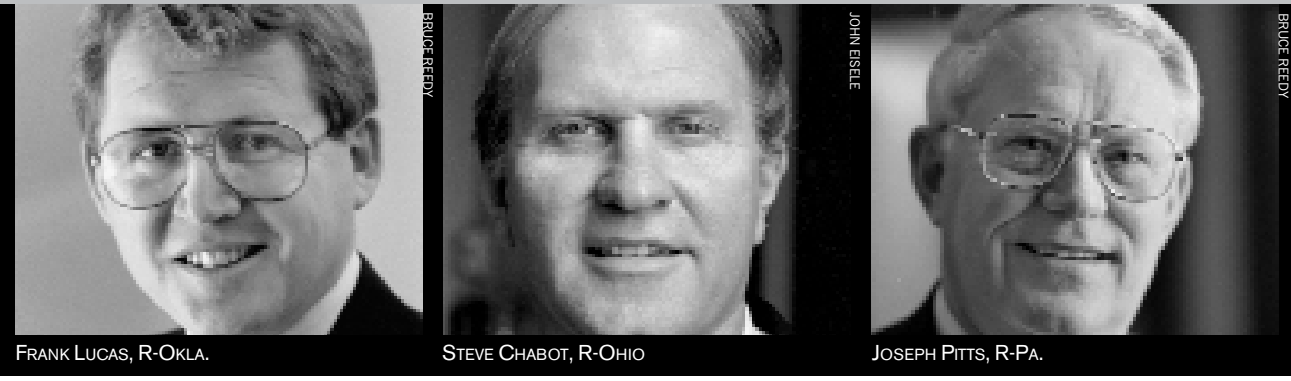

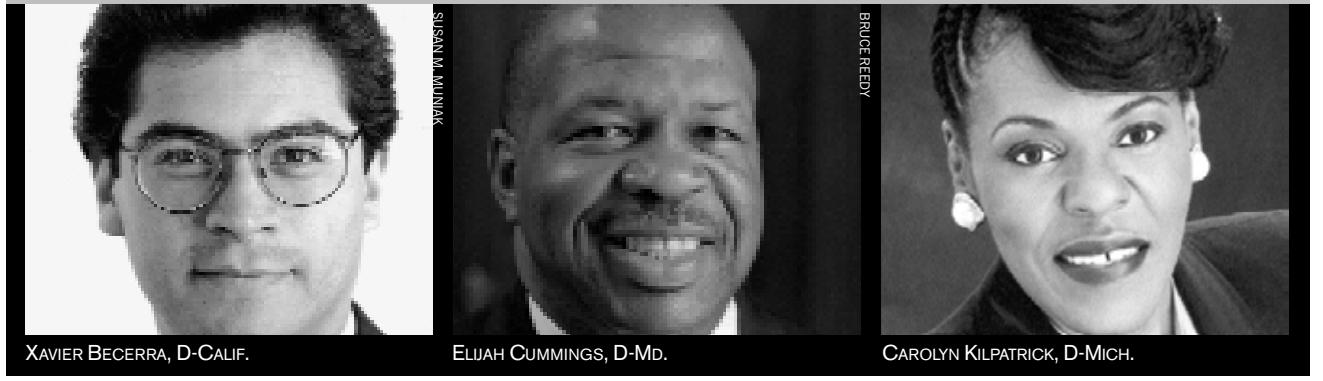
